REGULATION
Cup of Siberia
Open winter sailing sports championship of the Novosibirsk Oblast

27th of November – 2th of December, 2018

City of Novosibirsk

1. General provisions

The Cup of Siberia is the open winter sailing sports championship of the Novosibirsk Oblast (hereinafter *the competition*) and will take place in accordance with the calendar of competitions of the Russian Yachting Federation (RYF) for 2018; furthermore, with the official physical education and sports event calendar for the Novosibirsk Oblast for 2018 and the OOO “FPS NSO” calendar of sports events for 2018.

The main objectives are:

- Attracting the general public to regular physical exercise and outdoors recreational activities during the winter period;
- Improving the athletic mastership of the snow kiting competitors;
- Fulfilling and confirming the class norms;
- Determining the best athletes in the snow kiting class.

2. Dates and place of the competition

The competition will take place from the 29th of November until the 4th of December, 2017, on the territory of the Novosibirsk water reservoir, close to the Ob’ power plant, at the Surf Station “Bumerang”, located at: Sofiyskaya Ulitsa 15, Novosibirsk

3. Hosts of the competition

The management of the competition will be under the responsibility of the “Novosibirsk Oblast Yachting Federation” LLC (hereinafter *the Federation*), the Surf Station “Boomerang”, the RPS Association “Wind’s House” as well as the competition’s own Organizing Committee. Informational support will be provided by the physical education and sports department of the Novosibirsk Oblast (hereinafter *the Department*). The immediate organization of the competition will be carried out by the race committee. The president of the race committee has the status of the competition’s main judge. 4. Rules

4.1. The competition will be held according to the rules set forth in the RRS-17 (The Racing Rules of Sailing), according to the PPS IKA in effect at the time, according to the VFPS regulations titled “Competition System for Sailing Sports Included in the Calendar of the Russian Yachting Federation”, the provisions regarding interregional and all-Russian sailing sports competitions for 2017 issued by the Ministry of Sports of Russia, furthermore by these regulations and the race instructions.

4.2. Competitions for the discipline “Freestyle” will be held using rules based on the rules of the Professional Kiteboard Riders Association (PKRA).

4.3. Competitions for the Winter Windsurfing class will be held using rules set forth in the WWR4 rules for Winter Windsurfing competitions.

5. Advertising

The gear and crews have to comply with rule no. 80 of the RRS-17.

The participants are obliged to wear the advertising selected and provided by the managing organizations.

6. Requirements for participants of the competition and conditions for their admission

6.1. In order to be admitted to the competition, athletes have to:

6.2. Be Citizens of the Russian Federation, over 18 years of age and members of the Federation of Sailing Sports of the Novosibirsk Oblast.

6.3. Be 14 years of age as of the starting date of the competition.

6.4. Foreign athletes may participate in the competition if they are invited by the Federation.

6.5. Only athletes with a valid medical admission for this competition are allowed to participate.

6.6. Athletes younger than 14 years of age may be allowed to participate upon the decision of the main judge and only if accompanied by an adult representative.

6.7. All athletes must have valid life and health insurance policies against accidents during the competition according to the effective regulations of the RYF regarding insurance.

6.8. Athletes must have sufficient kiting of winter windsurfing skills in order to ensure the safety of the other participants of the competition. Protective helmets are mandatory for the "Course Race" races, spine-protecting devices are mandatory for the "Freestyle" discipline.

7. Applications for participation

7.1. Upfront registration will be open at www.kuboksibiri.ru until the 25th of November, 2018

7.2. The Credentials Committee is located on the premises of the Surf Station "Boomerang".

7.3. The following documents will have to be presented during the registration:

7.3.1. Application for participation in the competition (annex 1 to this regulation).

7.3.2. Russian passport

7.3.3. In case of temporary registration, a document confirming the temporary registration.

7.3.4. Confirmation of your membership in the Federation of Sailing Sports of the Novosibirsk Oblast for the Open Championship of the Novosibirsk Oblast of the Cup of Siberia (for Russian citizens aged 18 years and older).

7.3.5. Medical admission for these competitions.

7.3.6. The original document confirming a valid life and health insurance against accidents with an insurance amount not less than 100 000 (one hundred thousand) Rubles.

7.3.7. Confirmation of sports qualification (qualification book / certificate).

7.4. The non-refundable entry fee is:

7.4.1. For athletes younger than 18 years: 1000 Rubles;

7.4.2. For anyone else: 2500 Rubles.

7.5. For participants who handed in their applications after the 25th of November, 2017, the entry fee is:

7.5.1. For athletes younger than 18 years: 1000 Rubles;

7.5.2. For anyone else: 3000 Rubles.

8. Competition Schedule

27th of November, 2018 – day of arrival of the participants:

The “Warning” signal for the training race will be given at 15:00;

Registration from 17:00 until 21:00.

28th of November, 2018:

Registration from 10:00 until 11:30;

Competition Opening Ceremony 12:00;

The “Warning” signal for the first race will be given at 14:00;

The “Warning” signal for the last race of the day will be given at 17:30;

29th of November – 1st of December, 2018:

Meeting of participants 10:00;

The “Warning” signal for the first race will be given at 11:00;

The “Warning” signal for the last race of the day will be given at 17:30;

2nd of December, 2018

meeting of participants 10:00;

The “Warning” signal for the marathon race will be given at 11:00;

Award Ceremony, Competition Closing Ceremony 16:00

3th of December, 2018: departure day of the participants.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to change the schedule for security reasons and/or in order to hold the competitions in a technically adequate manner.

9. Race Instructions

The Race Instructions will be available on the official information board from 18:00 on, on the 27th of November, 2018. The distance scheme will be included in the Race Instructions.

10. Scoring system, determining the winners

10.1. This is an individual competition.

10.2. These are the main scoring groups:

Snowkiting Course Race – Ski;

Snowkiting Course Race – Board;

Snowkiting Freestyle – Ski;

Snowkiting Freestyle – Board;

Winter Windsurfing.

Additional scoring groups:

Snowkiting Course Race – Ski – Board “Women”;

Snowkiting Course Race – Ski – Board “Juniors” (14–18 years);

Snowkiting Course Race – Ski – Board “Masters” (40–49 years);

Snowkiting Course Race – Ski – Board “Grandmasters” (50 years and above);

Snowkiting Freestyle – Ski – Board “Women”;

Snowkiting Freestyle – Ski – Board “Amateurs”;

Winter Windsurfing – “Women” and “Juniors”;

Marathon with a joint launch for Snowkiting (Ski, Boards) and Winter Windsurfing.

- 10.3. In classes with a joint launch, the scores will be determined separately for Women, Juniors, Masters and Grandmasters according to the scores obtained in the total scoring.
- 10.4. In the discipline “Course Race”, the competition will be considered valid if at least five races have been held.
- 10.5. 12 races are scheduled in each class.
- 10.6. If between 5 and 9 races are held, the scores of a participant in a series equal the sum of the scores he earned in all races, except for the one worst result.
- 10.7. If 10 or more races are held, the scores of a participant in a series equal the sum of the scores he earned in all races, except for the two worst results.
- 10.8. The scoring system is linear.
- 10.9. The winner in the class Snowkiting Course Race – Ski and Snowkiting Course Race – Board will be determined by the least sum of scores. The winner in the class Snowkiting Freestyle – Ski and Snowkiting Course Race – Board will be determined by the highest sum of scores.
- 10.10. The “Freestyle” competition will be held as a double elimination competition, with pairwise elimination runs. The competition will be considered valid if at least one single series has been held – single elimination, semi-final, final.
- 10.11. In order to officially approve the results of a separate scoring group, at least 10 athletes have to participate in it.

11. Awarding

- 11.1. In the official scoring groups Snow Kiting Course Race – Ski, Snow Kiting Course Race – Board, Snow Kiting Freestyle – Ski, Snow Kiting Freestyle – Board and Winter Windsurfing, the athletes will be awarded cups, medals and certificates issued by the Department.
- 11.2. Athletes winning medal places in the additional scoring groups will be awarded cups, medals, certificates and sports prizes from the sponsors and the competition organizers.
- 11.3. Awarding procedure:
- 11.3.1. If 5 or more athletes participate in a scoring group, the winner will be awarded a cup, a prize, a certificate and a medal; the second- and third-placed athletes will be awarded certificates and medals according to their placement.
- 11.3.2. If 4 athletes participate in a scoring group, the winner will be awarded a prize, a medal and a certificate; the athlete who won the second place will be awarded a medal and a second-place certificate; the third-placed athlete will not be awarded.
- 11.3.3. If 3 athletes participate in a scoring group, the winner will be awarded a certificate and a medal. The athlete who won the second place will not be awarded.
- 11.3.4. If 2 athletes participate in a scoring group, there will be no awards.
- 11.4. The organizers and sponsors may establish additional prizes
- 11.5. The awards for the basic score groups are described in the following table:

12. Funding conditions

The department will provide awarding paraphernalia and catering for the judges through GAU NSO “ZSP NSO”. The Federation, Surf Station “Boomerang”, the Association RPS “Wind’s House” and the Organizing Committee will bear the technical costs of the competition.

Travel costs for participants, coaches and specialists, their accommodation and meals, the transportation of equipment to the competition premises and other costs associated with personal participation in the competition shall be borne by the sending organizations and the competitors.

13. Ensuring the safety of the participants and spectators

13.1. All athletes, coaches and representatives participate in the competition at their own risk (see rule no.4 RRS-17: “The yacht is solely responsible for its decision to participate in or continue to participate in the race”). The Race Committee, the organizers and any other parties are not responsible or liable for the life and property of the competition participants as well as for any possible physical harm, harm done to property or any inconvenience caused which might occur to the participant or his representative or his property, on the shore as well as on the ice, at the competition as well as in connection with the competition. Every participant or his representative accepts these conditions by signing the application form.

13.2. The participants of the competition must:

13.2.1. Adhere to safety measures (including environmental) and the rules of conduct on ice and on the competition premises;

13.2.2. Comply with requests by persons performing official functions. This includes presence at official ceremonies and communication with the competition sponsors;

13.2.3. Behave in a manner that does not violate general codes of conduct and the legislation of the Russian Federation.

13.3. Equipment requirements: the participants and coaches have to wear their club or team clothes at all official events, from the moment of registration until their departure.

13.4. It is prohibited to unlawfully influence the results of this official sports competition and to take part in gambling at bookmaker companies and sweepstakes by betting on the official sports competition. This is in accordance with article 26.2 of the Federal Law of 04 December 2017 No. 329–FZ “Regarding Physical Education and Sports in the Russian Federation”.
